## Building the Right Foundation.

Imagine that you've been chosen to ride a roller coaster for the first time—the biggest, the fastest, the most amazing ride ever. What if you knew something was wrong with he foundation? Would you be willing to be the first to give it a try?

When the foundation of the building is wrong, everything that goes on top it is wrong too. I'm writing this article from a perfect example.

Right now, I'm sitting in a house that my family built. The only problem is that when the foundation was laid, it was mis-measured and shortened by 1 foot on the backside.



Guess what? Because the foundation is missing a foot, everything above it is missing a foot too.

If you build your life on the wrong foundation, it will affect everything you do and everything you become.

But God has the right foundation for your life. God wants you to build your life on His truth and to never stray from it.
